

## S.A. money manager earns top rankings

Martin Capital Advisors LLP (MCA), a moneymanagement firm with offices in San Antonio and Austin, received top rankings from a firm that tracks money managers' investment performance.

MCA earned 15 "Top Guns" rankings from Informa Investment Solutions' <u>Planned Sponsor Network</u> database for the three months, year, three years and five years ended March 31.

MCA Flexible Portfolios were ranked in the "All Cap Equity" universe, which included 354 managers and 508 investment products. The portfolios also were ranked "Bull and Bear Masters," finishing in the top 10 of over 3,300 equity investment products for performance in bull and bear markets.

MCA Balanced and Conservative Portfolios were ranked in the "Balanced" universe, comprised of 168 managers and 249 investment products.
